## NOTE: For any student to be eligible for work-based learning (WBL), the following MUST be true.

- Successfully completed 3 classes in a single career pathway (internship/apprenticeship), or 4 classes for co-op placement
- Meet the minimum GPA requirements (2.0) for the semester prior to placement
- No more than 4 unexcused absences (or equivalent) the semester prior to/during placement
- Have an 'exemption' form for any one of these requirements signed by a school principal (available from a principal)
- The WBL placement CANNOT be supervised by a family member
- Students must have a valid industry certification, passed the EOP in the appropriate pathway, or made a C or above in a pathway dual-credit course to participate.

## Types of Work-Based Learning

- Unpaid Internship (must be a named course available in the specific pathway)
- Paid Internship (must be a named course available in the specific pathway)
- Entrepreneurship (student-owned, legally registered company in a career pathway)
- Cooperative Education (Co-op)

## **KEES Information**

 Work-based learning placement may have an impact on KEES scholarship funds. Please speak to your Guidance Counselor for more information.

## NOTE

 In order for students to continue in their WBL placement throughout the semester, they must document their experiences using the provided forms with the support of their teachers and supervisors, and their GPA and attendance must continue to meet the requirements.
